



## Asset Management Levels of Service Survey

The United Counties of Leeds and Grenville is currently updating its Asset Management Plan (AMP). Asset management helps us make decisions about the service delivery of our infrastructure and assets, such as roads and buildings. **This survey is part of meeting the United Counties of Leeds and Grenville’s obligations with the provincial regulation.**

**The survey closes on April 6, 2022.**

An important part of developing the AMP is getting the community’s feedback on what levels of service you expect from the infrastructure that we operate, maintain, repair and replace. This information helps us better manage our infrastructure assets to meet your current needs, while planning for the service needs of the future.

The purpose of this community survey is to engage with members of the public about levels of service related to asset management in the Counties. This survey asks for your input on:

- Your satisfaction with municipal services
- Your suggestions for service improvements
- Your willingness to pay to maintain or increase services
- Your service priorities for funding allocation

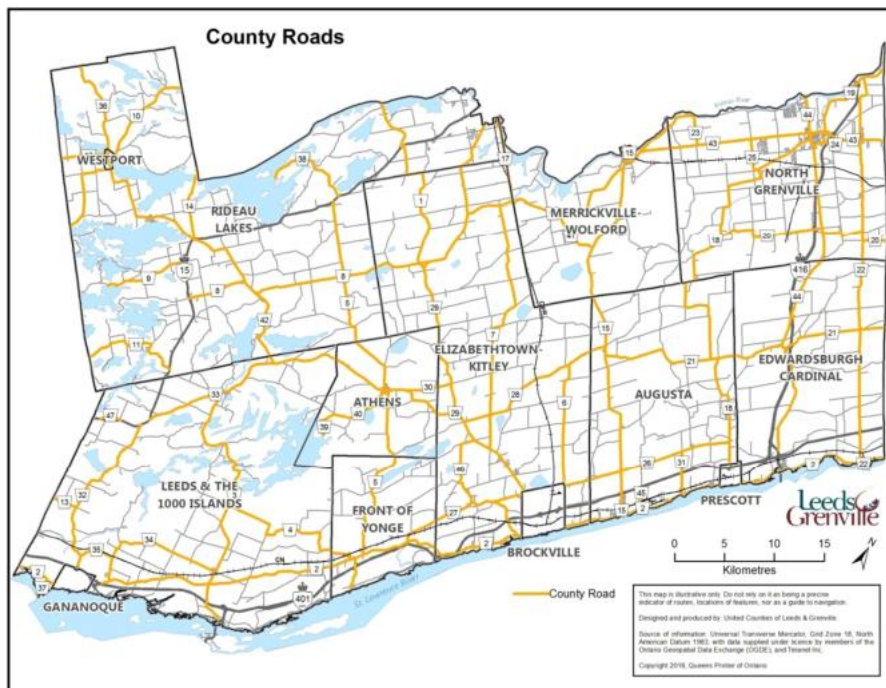
### **How would you allocate the limited funding available to deliver services in your community?**
