All loops **start and end** at the Tourist Information Centre.

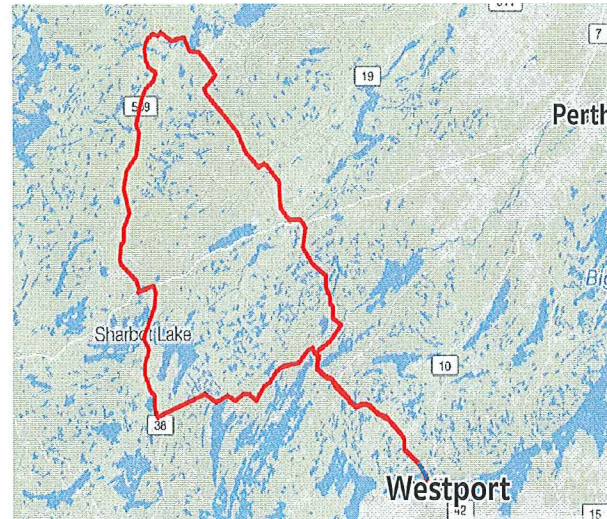
**Free parking** at the Arena two blocks away from the Tourist Centre.

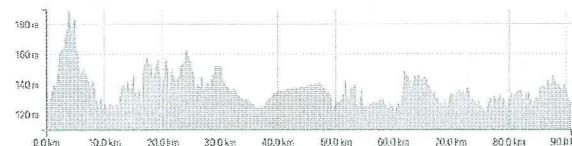

106km, +1251m / 66mi, +4104ft



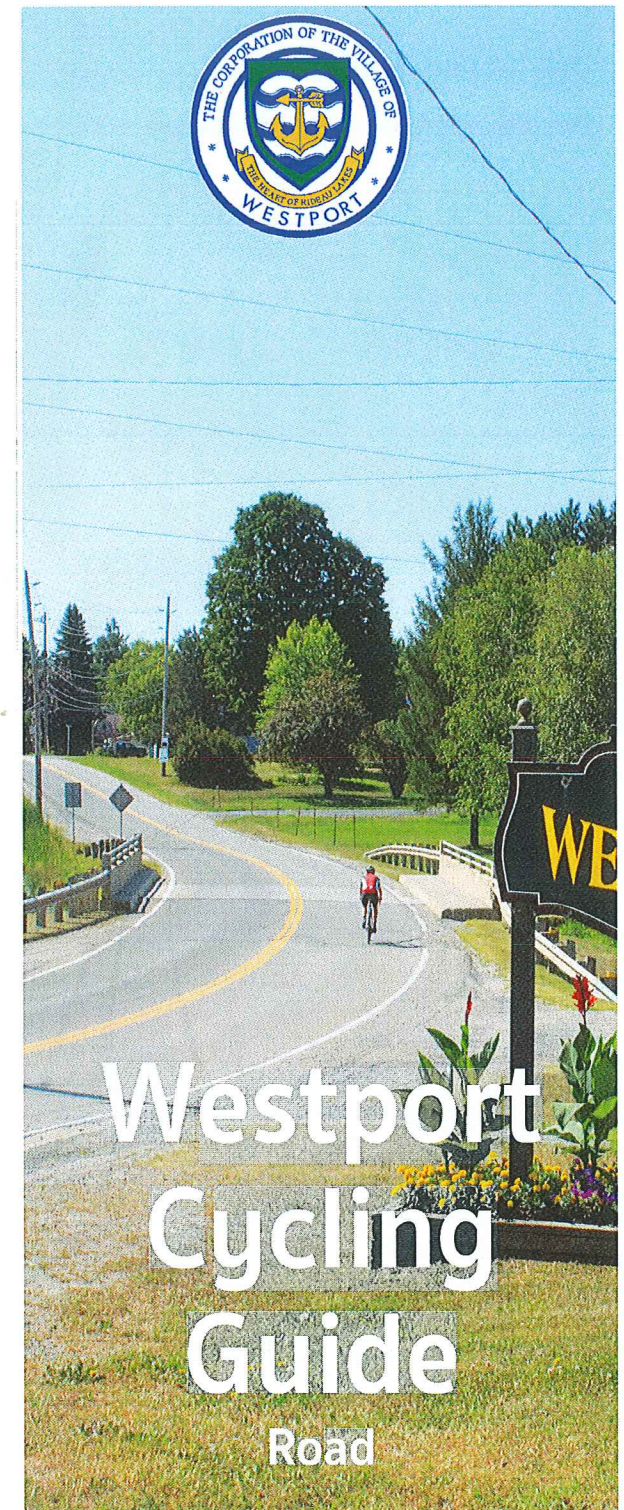
Elevation Profile

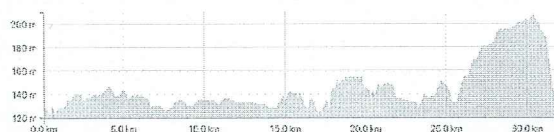


## Narrows Lock

31km, +260m / 19mi, 853ft

The flat and rolling route is a great ride along the beautiful North Shore. Keep your eyes peeled for wildlife! Narrows Lock dates back to the 1830s and is a stunning place to stop. The road from Westport to Newboro can be busy but Newboro is a great place to stop for ice cream. Clockwise has an early climb; counterclockwise the climbs are in the last ten kilometers.

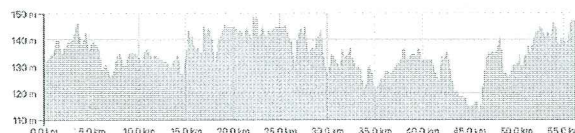


## Harlem

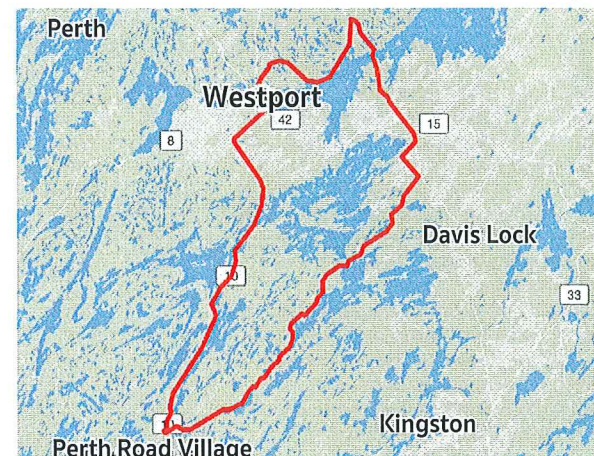

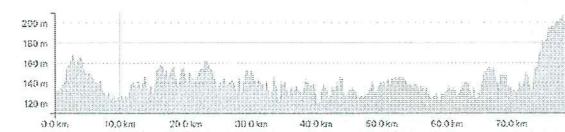


## Chaffey's Lock

80km, +808m / 50mi, +2650ft

Difficulty:

One of our favourites! Chaffey's Lock dates back 1833 and is still used today. A beautiful rolling route that is best started early in the day to avoid the busier times on highway 10. Keep an eye out for deer on Opinicon Road. Stop at Chaffey's not just for the view but for drinks or even lunch at The Opinicon which has a restaurant, pub, and ice cream shop open 7 days a week.
